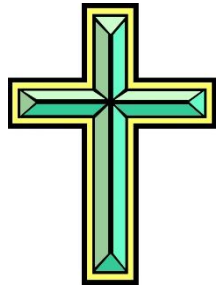


The Parish of The Isles of Scilly
