All are invited to receive communion as they remain at their seats. Communicants are invited to put on their face coverings at this point, to sanitise their hands, to stand as the president approaches and stretch out their hand to receive the consecrated bread upon it. Once the president has moved on, the communicant is invited to remove their face covering to receive the sacrament (and for the remainder of the service). They are then invited to sit down and sanitise their hands once again. Anyone not wishing to receive communion should remain seated as a sign to the president.
